Lesson: Shahada (Pillars of Islam)

## A. Inquiry:

The Shadah is the first pillar of Islam and is the pledge made by a Muslim towards God which sums up a person's faith and belief. Its words are few but extremely significant. "I bear witness that there is no God except Allah, I bear witness that Muhammad (SAW) is Allah's messenger." By reciting the Shahada a person, whether they were born amongst Muslims or are converting later in their lifetime, becomes part of umma through their common faith and through brotherhood regardless of their race, caste or social position.
